- Unlimited travel throughout Southern Quebec and Southern Ontario.
- Up to 10 consecutive days of unlimited travel.
- Additional charges to upgrade to Sleeper and First Class
- Children: 2-11 years inclusive
- Students: 12-17 years inclusive, 18+yrs with ISIC card
- Seniors: 60+years

### Conditions

- Pass prices are subject to change, due to the exchange rate.
- Canadian bookings need to be paid within 14 days of loading the booking or the booking will auto cancel.
- Residents of Canada are eligible to purchase and use a Corridorpass.
- Not valid for more than one round trip between the same cities. (For the purposes of this pass, Toronto includes Guildwood station; Montreal includes Dorval and St.Lambert stations; Quebec City includes Ste-Foy and Charny stations)
- The Corridor Pass must be purchased at least 5 days prior to the first travel date. First date of use and first leg of journey must be advised at time of booking.
- Passes are valid for comfort class (economy) or VIA 1 class (first) class of travel. A supplement is payable for sleeper accommodation.
- A ticket/reservation must be obtained for each journey. It is recommended to book early as Comfort Class seats for passholders are limited.
- First date of use and first leg of journey must be advised at time of booking.
- Age, school ID card or age and ISIC card are required for student fares and must be produced locally on

### Ketunas

- Passes must be presented for refund unused and with all tickets issued against the card have been surrendered.
  - Unused tickets must be returned marked "cancelled" by a VIA rail official
  - Once a Corridorpasses has been used it is totally non-refundable.
  - Corridorpasses are not transferable and cannot be refunded if lost or stolen
  - GST is non refundable
  - A 25% cancellation fee applies to totally unused passes returned with 1 year of issuing date.
