### Explore Canada from one end to the other with a Canrail Pass

Discover Canada with a Canrailpass. The Canrailpass gives you access to Canada's extensive VIA Rail network. Take a trans Canadian journey on the legendary "Canadian" service between Toronto and Vancouver or visit French influenced Quebec on a Corridor service train.



The Canrailpass offers a minimum of 12 days travel which can be utilised any time within 30 days. You can also add up to 3 additional days of travel if your itinerary is more extensive. There are also reduced fares for children and seniors.

PEAK AND OFF PEAK DATES 2008

Off-peak season: Jan 01 to May 31 and Oct 16 to Dec 31

Peak season: Jun 1 to Oct 15

Passengers who's travel dates include any portion of the peak season must purchase a peak pass.

#### Fare types

**Adult**

**Child:** 2 - 17 years

**Senior:** 60+

#### Extra information

Residents of Canada are eligible to purchase and use a Canrail Pass

Passes are valid for comfort class (economy) travel. A supplement is payable for VIA 1 class and sleeper accommodation.

A ticket/reservation must be obtained for each journey. It is recommended to book early as Comfort Class seats for passholders are limited.

First date of use and first leg of journey must be advised at time of booking.

During the peak summer season, an upgrade to Silver & Blue class (between Vancouver and Toronto) and to Totem and Totem Deluxe classes (between Prince Rupert and Jasper) can only be arranged in the 21 days prior to departure.

Age, school ID card or age and ISIC card are required for student fares and must be produced locally on request.

## Conditions

- Costs are subject to change weekly due to the exchange rate
- All Canadian bookings need to be paid within 14 days of loading the booking or the booking will auto cancel.
- Passes are valid for comfort class (economy) travel. A supplement is payable for VIA 1 class and sleeper accommodation.
- A ticket/reservation must be obtained for each journey. It is recommended to book early as Comfort Class seats for passholders are limited.
- First date of use and first leg of journey must be advised at time of booking.
- During the peak summer season, an upgrade to Silver & Blue class (between Vancouver and Toronto) and to Totem and Totem Deluxe classes (between Prince Rupert and Jasper) can only be arranged in the 21 days prior to departure.
- Child Age: 2-17 years inclusive.

## Refunds

- Passes must be presented for refund unused and with all tickets issued against the card have been surrendered.
- Unused tickets must be returned marked "cancelled" by a VIA rail official
- Once a Canrailpass has been used it is totally non-refundable.
- Canrailpasses are not transferable and cannot be refunded if lost or stolen
- GST is non refundable
- A 25% cancellation fee applies to totally unused passes returned with 1 year of issuing date.
